DO I NEED INSURANCE?

Regardless of the rental company you rent from their insurance will not cover any loss or damages when you have the equipment in your possession. There are no insurance companies that offer this kind of coverage. There are however things you can do to protect yourself. If you are a homeowner that rents only occasionally check with your homeowner insurance carrier for coverage. If you have a large project and will need several rental items or if you are in construction industry we recommend that you acquire a blanket rental equipment coverage from your insurance carrier and provide us with a loss payee form. This is usually available as a rider from your insurance carrier.

There are some rental companies who offer a DAMAGE WAIVER sometimes called a RENTAL PROTECTION PLAN. We have found these plans to be lacking in real coverage and extremely expensive usually 15% of your rental bill. Your best plan is simply to provide your own coverage through your provider.

MULTIPLE USERS ALLOWED?

There is no problem with using our equipment to perform work for others. Companies can also assign operators to perform tasks, however it is not allowed to let other individuals use the equipment rented under your name. Allowing others to use equipment you rented is called re renting and is strictly prohibited. If you allow others to use the equipment you have assumed the responsibility for any and all damages they might cause to other people including themselves or damage to personal property. Under no circumstances allow others to tow any equipment you rented. If you allow others to tow the equipment rented under your name you have assumed all responsibilty for any damage they might cause to other people including themselves and any damaged property.

MISCELLANOUS FEES?

The published or verbal quote you get from Maryville Rental is the price you will be charged. Most companies have fees they add to the price, these are in the form of damage waiver 15% and host of other fees. The price you pay from them is usually 18% to 20% percent higher than the quoted rate. Other than sales tax and fuel you use there are NO ADDITIONAL FEES at Maryville Equipment Rental. You may be required to show proof of insurance coverage for equipment that has a a replace cost over fifty thousand dollars
